RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE  
DECLARING THAT THE WORK OF CLOSING UP AND VACATING A PORTION OF REDWOOD  
DRIVE IN SAID CITY HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND THAT THE SAME IS CLOSED UP AND  
VACATED.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did, on the  
30th day of March, 1926, pass its Resolution No. 890 (New Series) ordering  
the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Redwood Drive in said City,  
hereinafter described as contemplated by the Resolution of Intention No.  
855 (New Series) and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported  
to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said por-  
tion of Redwood Drive has been done and completed,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City  
of Riverside hereby declares that the portion of Redwood Drive in said City  
hereinafter described is closed up and vacated as a public street of said City.

The portion of Redwood Drive hereinbefore referred to and affect-  
ed by this Resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

That the following portion of Redwood Drive, as shown on the Amend-  
ed Map of the Indian Hill Tract, per map of record in Book of Maps, 10, page  
3, records of Riverside County, California, be closed up and vacated.

Beginning at the Southeasterly corner of Lot "J" of said  
Tract; thence South 53 degrees 37 minutes East along the  
Southerly line of said Street, 120.58 feet; thence North  
12 degrees, 23 minutes West 75.85 feet to the Northerly  
line of said Street; thence North 53 degrees 37 minutes  
West to the Easterly line of said Lot "J"; thence South  
32 degrees 15 minutes West, 50.13 feet to the point of  
beginning.

I, G. Albert Mills, the Duly elected, qualified and acting clerk  
of the City of Riverside, California, do hereby certify that the foregoing
