

RESOLUTION NO. 1
(NEW SERIES)

Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside, declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Brockton Avenue in said City has been completed and that the same is closed up and vacated.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 5th. day of July, 1927 pass its Resolution No. 1160 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Brockton Avenue in said City, hereinafter described as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1120 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Brockton Avenue has done and completed,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that that certain portion of Brockton Avenue in said City hereinafter described is closed up and vacated.

That portion of Brockton Avenue referred to and affected by this resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Southerly line of Lot 247, Southern California Colony Association Lands, as recorded in Book 7 of Maps, page 3, Records of San Bernardino County, California, 43 feet Westerly from the South easterly corner of Lot 247; thence Northerly parallel to the Easterly lines of Lots 247, 240, 229, and 222 said Southern California Colony

Association Lands to the Northerly line of said lot 222; thence Westerly along the Northerly line of said lot 222; four (4) feet; thence Southerly in a direct line to the point of beginning, Saving and excepting all existing streets that intersect.

The above described triangular parcel of land lies along the Westerly line of Brockton Avenue, between Rubidoux Avenue and Bandini Avenue.
