

RESOLUTION NO. 114
(NEW SERIES)

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Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Howard Avenue, in said City has been , completed and that the same is closed up and vacated.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 7th. day of June, 1927. pass its resolution No. 1127 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Howard Avenue in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1103 (New Series) and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Howard Avenue, has been done and completed.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Common Council of the City of Riverside, hereby declares that that certain portion of Howard Avenue in said City, hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

The portion of Howard Avenue referred to and affected by this resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of Howard Avenue in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, lying between the Northerly line of East 13th. Street, and Southerly line of the Alley between Blocks 8 and 9, Santa Fe Tract as R_ecorded in Book 6 of Maps, page 14 records of San Bernardino County, California.
