

RESOLUTION NO. 4107.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DEED.

RESOLVED, that that certain deed of the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation, dated November 6, 1946, quitclaiming to Walter E. and Martha E. Toy, as joint tenants, that portion of the abandoned right-of-way of the Lower Canal of the Riverside Water Company situated northerly of and adjoining Lot 12, of Palm Addition, on the northerly side of McCray Street, between Magnolia Avenue and Brockton Avenue, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 12 of Palm Addition, as recorded in Book 6 page 50 of Maps, records of San Bernardino County, California; thence northerly along the westerly line of said Lot 12, produced northerly, 12.78 feet; thence easterly, parallel to the northerly line of McCray Street, 50 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of said Lot 12; thence westerly along the northerly line of said Lot 12 to the point of beginning;

be, and the same is hereby, approved, and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Riverside.
