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This Indenture, made this 26th day of Marcy, A. D. 1907, between the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation of the six class, organized and existing under the law of the State of California, the party of the first part, and S. A. White of said City of Riverside, California, the party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, that in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), lawful money of the United States, to it in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt wherefor is hereby acknowledged, and for other good and valuable considerations, the said party of the first part does hereby quitclaim and convey to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

That part of an alley situated in Block Eight, Range Seven, of the City of Riverside, as is marked "Abandoned" and colored red in diagram fastened hereto with eyelets, and dated January 16, 1907, and enclosed in same file wrapper.

TOGETHER with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, the above named property possession, claim and demand whatsoever as well as in law as in equity, of the said parties of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every party thereto with the appurtenances.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

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IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said party of the first part has by resolution of its Board of Trustees, caused its corporate name to be subscribed to these presents by the President of its Board of Trustees, attested by the Clerk of said City, and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed, the day and year first above written.
