THIS INDENTURE, made this 16 day of Nov, 1936
by and between Theodore Chalgren and Adelia M Chalgren, his wife
Charles A. Lee and Duzilla Lee, his wife

of the City of Riverside, California, (Grantor(s), and the City of
Riverside, a municipal corporation, situated in the County of Riverside,
California, Grantee.

WITNESSETH: That the said Grantor hereby grants unto the said
Grantee an easement of right-of-way for electric poles, lines and wires,
overhanging at a minimum distance from the surface of the ground, as
specified by the California Railroad Commission, over and across that
certain real property situated in the City of Riverside, County of
Riverside, State of California, as shown in sketch on reverse side, and
particularly described as follows:

A strip of land four feet in width, lying two feet on each side
of line described as follows: Beginning at the most northwesterly
corner of lot 199, of the lands of the Southern California Colony
Association, a map of which is recorded in book 7 of maps, page 3,
Records of San Bernardino County, California, thence southerly along
the westerly line of said lot 199 a distance of 388.23 feet, thence
parallel with and 388.23 feet from the northerly line of said lot
199 easterly a distance of 33 ft. to a point of beginning; thence
parallel with and 388.23 ft. from the northerly line of said lot 199
easterly a distance of 423 feet.



ACCEPTING AN EASEMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR AN ELECTRIC POLE LINE.




