 4 existing under the laws of the State of California, a right  
 5 of way for the construction, maintenance and operation of a  
 6 public sewer along a line in the City of Riverside, County  
 7 of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:  
 8 Beginning at a point on the Southerly line of Terquesquete  
 9 Avenue and lying twenty-five feet Westerly from the Easterly  
 10 line of Lot one hundred and fifty-eight of the lands of the  
 11 Southern California Colony Association, a map of which is of  
 12 record in the County Recorder's office of San Bernardino  
 13 County, California; thence Southerly and parallel with the  
 14 Easterly line of said lot one hundred and fifty-eight, a dis-  
 15 tance of one hundred and forty feet, more or less, to the  
 16 waste canal of the Riverside Water Company.
