 wires, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment and fix-
 tures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone

 of electric energy, petroleum and its products, ammonia, water, and
 incidental purposes, including access and the right to keep the
 property free from inflammable materials, and wood growth, and

 44 determine that the public convenience and best city require the
 45 reservation of easements encumbrances and rights of way at any time
 46 and from time to time to construct, maintain, operate, replace,
 47 remove and erect sanitary sewers, gas and water mains and apartment
 48 structures, in, upon over and across the portion of the street
 49 proposed to be vacated, and pursuant to any existing franchises or
 50 permits thereof, or of course, to construct, install, operate,
 51 replace, remove, renew or enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables,
 52 wires, poles, and other apparatus, equipment and struc-
 53 tures for the operation of gas, telephone, telegraphic and tele-
 54 vision lines, railroad lines, and for the transportation or distribution
 55 of electric energy, petroleum and its products, steam, water, and
 56 incidental purposes, and also to have the right to keep the
 57 property free from inflammable materials, and weed growth, and
 58 otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the
