

EASEMENT

This instrument made this 7th day of January, in the year of our Lord, 1954, between Trustees of Olivewood Cemetery by H.D. Hall, S.L. Adler and W.C. Evans, parties of the first part, and the City of Riverside, a Municipal Corporation, of the State of California, the party of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant unto said party of the second part a perpetual easement and right of way for the construction, reconstruction, operation, replacement, repair and maintenance of public improvements in, over, under, along and across the following described property:


A strip of land 12 feet in width lying adjacent to and parallel to the Southeasterly right of way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad, formerly the Riverside, Santa Ana and Los Angeles Railway Company, per deed recorded August 26, 1836, in book 48 page 253 of Deeds, San Bernardino County Records, and extending from the right of way known as Central Avenue and running North-easterly to the property now owned by F. David Young and Mary W. Young per deed recorded April 23, 1953, in book 1464 page 553, Official Records of Riverside County, California, all within the City of Riverside, California.


Together with the right to enter upon and to pass and repass over and along said strip of land and to deposit tools, implements and other material thereon by said party of the second part, its officers, agents or employees, and by persons under contract with it and their employees whenever and wherever necessary in carrying out the purposes of this easement.



RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING AN EASEMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED that an easement, dated January 7, 1954, executed by the Olivewood Cemetery, by H. D. Hall, trustee, S. L. Adler, trustee, and W. C. Evans, trustee, granting a perpetual easement and right-of-way for the construction, reconstruction, operation, replacement, repair and maintenance of public improvements, in, over, under, along and across a strip of land 12 feet in width, lying adjacent to and parallel to the southeasterly right-of-way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad, formerly the Riverside, Santa Ana and Los Angeles Railway Company, being more particularly described in said easement, be, and the same is hereby officially accepted.
