ORDINANCE NO. 2049

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS IN RIVERSIDE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT - McNEW TRACT; REFERRING TO MAP AS TO THE STREETS AND ALLEYS SOUGHT TO BE VACATED; AND SETTING THE TIME OF HEARING.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, to vacate the hereinafter described streets and alleys in Riverside Industrial Development Project - McNew Tract, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, as shown by Amended Map recorded in Map Book 20, at page 17, Records of Riverside County, upon the grounds and for the reason that said streets and alleys are unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes. The said City Council hereby elects and expresses its election to proceed to vacate said streets and alleys pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.

Section 2: That the streets and alleys which it is the intention of the City Council to vacate are described as follows:

- Those streets and alleys, also shown as lots, on the Amended Map of Riverside Industrial Development Project - McNew Tract, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 20, at page 17, Records of Riverside County, described as follows:
- All of Ledge Avenue, also shown as Lot F;
- All of Merriman Avenue, also shown as Lot L;
- All of Newwood Avenue, also shown as Lots N and J;
- All of Maplewood Avenue, also shown as Lots C, I, and O;
- All of Lakewood Avenue, also shown as Lots D, H, and P;
- All of Kenwood Avenue, also shown as Lots E, G, and Q;
- All of those alleys shown as Lots B, K, M, R, S, T, U, and V;

and that the streets and alleys sought to be vacated are shown on that certain map on file with the City Clerk of Riverside, California, and reference is hereby made to said map on file.
