2 RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING
4 THE PEDESTRIAN WALKS IN WALNUT GROVE TRACT AND
5 GALETA MANOR.

6 WHEREAS, on the 13th day of July, 1954, Ordinance No. 2089
7 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the
8 intention of the City Council to vacate the pedestrian walks in
9 Walnut Grove Tract and Galeta Manor, pursuant to the provisions
10 of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

11 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for
12 Tuesday, September 7, 1954, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council
13 Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets,
14 Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons
15 interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed
16 to be heard; and,

17 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section
18 50331 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

19 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had
20 before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at
21 which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard
22 by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all
23 of the evidence submitted that the pedestrian walks which the
24 legislative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary
25 for present or prospective public use.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the
27 City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian walks in
28 Walnut Grove Tract and Galeta Manor in the City of Riverside,
29 County of Riverside, State of California, and described as
30 follows:

31 All of Lots D, E, and F of Walnut Grove Tract,
32 as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 23, at
page 49, Records of Riverside County, with the
following reservations:

A Public Utility Easement five feet (5') in width

1 across the southwesterly end of said Lot D; a
Public Utility Easement ten feet (10') in width
2 across the northeasterly end of said Lot F; a
Public Utility Easement ten feet (10') in width
3 across said Lot G, the center line of said ease-
ment being located one hundred thirty-two feet
4 (132') northeasterly of and parallel with the
southwesterly line of said Lot E;

5 Also

6 All of Lots D and E of Galeta Manor, as shown on
a map recorded in Map Book 26, at page 29, Records
7 of Riverside County, with the following reservations;
Public Utility Easement ten feet (10') in width
8 across the southwesterly end of said Lot D; a
Public Utility Easement five feet (5') in width
9 across the northeasterly end of said Lot E;

10
11 are unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the
12 same be and are hereby vacated.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy
14 of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the
15 Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
