RESOLUTION NO. 6301

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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING PORTIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENTS OVER PORTIONS OF LOTS 49 TO 55, INCLUSIVE, AND LOTS 39 TO 48, INCLUSIVE, OF CANTERBURY ROAD TRACT.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of July, 1954, Ordinance No. 2088 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate portions of public utility easements over portions of Lots 49 to 55, inclusive, and Lots 39 to 48, inclusive, of Canterbury Road Tract, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, September 7, 1954, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacations be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the portions of the public utility easements which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions of the public utility easements over portions of Lots 49 to 55, inclusive, and Lots 39 to 48, inclusive, of Canterbury Road Tract, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

1 The northeasterly three feet (3') of that Public  
2 Utility Easement, ten feet (10') in width across  
3 the southwesterly ends of Lots 49 to 55, inclusive,  
4 of Canterbury Road Tract, as shown on a map recorded  
5 in Map Book 26, at page 2, Records of Riverside  
6 County; and

7 The southeasterly five feet (5') of that Public  
8 Utility Easement, ten feet (10') in width across  
9 the northwesterly ends of Lots 39 to 48, inclusive,  
10 of Canterbury Road Tract, as shown on a map recorded  
11 in Map Book 26, at page 2, Records of Riverside  
12 County, EXCEPTING the northeasterly ten feet (10')  
13 thereof in said Lot 39;

14 are unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same  
15 be and are hereby vacated.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy  
17 of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the  
18 Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
