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RESOLUTION NO. 6599

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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE OF INTENTION NO. 2170, AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING PORTIONS OF BEECHWOOD PLACE AND PALM AVENUE.

Vacation

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, adopted an ordinance of intention, No. 2170, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 5, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, declaring its intention to vacate portions of Beechwood Place and Palm Avenue, therein and hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the matter came on regularly for hearing before said City Council at the time and place fixed for hearing by said ordinance of intention, and said City Council heard and considered all of the evidence submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said City Council that it be and is hereby found and determined by said City Council that said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceedings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting, as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said portions of Beechwood Place and Palm Avenue therein described are unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes and should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that these portions of Beechwood Place and Palm Avenue in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows, to wit:

Certain portions of Beechwood Place and Palm

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Reference is made to a map of Riverside County, California, as recorded in Map Book No. 100, page 10, Records of Riverside County, and further described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northeasterly line of said lot 18 which is thirty and sixty-nine hundredths feet (30.69') northeasterly from the most northerly corner of Lot 18 in said subdivision; thence northeasterly along a curve concave to the south, having a radius of two hundred thirty-three feet (233'), said curve being tangent to the line of said Lot 18 at the point of beginning; a distance of forty-nine and thirty-three hundredths feet (49.33') to a point on the northeasterly line of said subdivision; thence northeasterly along said line, a distance of sixty-four and seventy-two hundredths feet (64.72'), to a point on the line of said Lot 18 and distant eighty-six and twenty-nine hundredths feet (86.29') from the most northerly corner of said Lot 18; thence southerly and easterly along the line of said Lot 18 to the point of beginning.

and the same are hereby vacated.

It is further ordered that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
