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ORDINANCE NO. 2368

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA,  
DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO  
VACATE A PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY IN ARLINGTON KNOLLS;  
REFERRING TO MAP ON FILE, AND FIXING TIME AND PLACE  
FOR HEARING PERSONS INTERESTED, PURSUANT TO THE PRO-  
VISIONS OF PUBLIC SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Riverside has elected and does hereby elect to proceed with the vacation of the hereinafter described pedestrian walkway under the Public Service Easements Vacation Law, being Article 5, Chapter 2, Part 1, Division 1, Title 5 of the Government Code of the State of California.

Section 2: That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Riverside to vacate the hereinafter described pedestrian walkway in Arlington Knolls in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, as per map recorded in Map Book 26, at pages 80 and 81, Records of Riverside County, California; and which pedestrian walkway is offered for dedication on said Map; and the said pedestrian walkway to be vacated being described as follows:

All of Lot E, also shown as Walkway, shown on a map of Arlington Knolls, recorded in Book 26 at pages 80 and 81 of Maps, Records of Riverside County;  
RESERVING THEREFROM a Public Utility Easement ten feet (10') in width, the northerly line of said easement being ninety-five feet (95') southerly from the northerly end of said Lot E, and the southerly line of said easement being ninety-five feet (95') northerly from the southerly end of said Lot E.

That a map or plat showing said pedestrian walkway to be vacated is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Riverside, California, and reference is made thereto.

Section 3: That the time and place for hearing of persons interested in the proposed vacation is hereby fixed as Tuesday, the 7th day of August, 1956, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers of the Riverside City Council, located in the City Hall, 3606 Seventh Street, Riverside, California. At said time and place

1 all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation  
2 will be heard.

3 Section 4: Notice of the proposed easement vacation shall  
4 be given as follows: Notices of the easement vacation shall be  
5 posted along the lines of the pedestrian walkway proposed to be  
6 vacated, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of hearing,  
7 and said notices shall be posted conspicuously and not more than  
8 three hundred (300) feet apart, and at least three (3) notices  
9 shall be posted. Said notices shall state the date of the adoption  
10 of said ordinance of intention and the time and place of said  
11 hearing. The City Clerk of the City of Riverside is directed to  
12 execute and attest said notices, and the Superintendent of Streets  
13 of said City is directed to post said notices, both on behalf of  
14 said City Council.

15 Section 5: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption  
16 of this ordinance and cause it to be published once in the  
17 Riverside Daily Press. This ordinance shall become  
18 effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
