ORDINANCE NO. 2510

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE PORTIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENTS OVER PORTIONS OF LOTS 1, 2, AND 5 OF LINDEN SQUARE; REFERRING TO MAP ON FILE, AND FIXING TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING PERSONS INTERESTED, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Riverside has elected and does hereby elect to proceed with the vacation of the hereinafter described portions of public utility easements under the Public Service Easements Vacation Law, being Article 5, Chapter 2, Part 1, Division 1, Title 5 of the Government Code of the State of California.

Section 2: That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Riverside to vacate the hereinafter described portions of public utility easements over Lots 1, 2, and 5 of Linden Square, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California; said portions of the public utility easements to be vacated being described as follows:

Portions of those certain Public Utility Easements lying between Lots 1, 2, and 5 of Linden Square, as shown by map on file in Book 31, page 62, of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California; said portions being more particularly described as follows:

That certain 10-foot Public Utility Easement whose center line is the common line between said Lots 1 and 2, and said Lots 1 and 5; EXCEPTING THEREFROM the Westerly 5 feet.

Also, that certain 10-foot Public Utility Easement whose center line is the common line between said Lots 2 and 5; EXCEPTING THEREFROM the Southerly 5 feet.

That a map or plat showing said portions of public utility easements to be vacated is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Riverside, California, and reference is made thereto.

Section 3: That the time and place for hearing of persons

1 interested in the proposed vacation is hereby fixed as Tuesday,
2 the 23rd day of July, 1957, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. in the Council
3 Chambers of the Riverside City Council, located in the City Hall,
4 3606 Seventh Street, Riverside, California. At said time and
5 place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed
6 vacation will be heard.

7 Section 4: Notice of the proposed easement vacation shall
8 be given as follows: Notices of the easement vacation shall be
9 posted along the line of the portions of the public utility
10 easements proposed to be vacated at least fifteen (15) days prior
11 to the date of hearing, and said notices shall be posted conspicu-
12 ously and not more than three hundred (300) feet apart, and at
13 least three (3) notices shall be posted. Said notices shall state
14 the date of the adoption of said ordinance of intention and the
15 time and place of said hearing. The City Clerk of the City of
16 Riverside is directed to execute and attest said notices, and
17 the Superintendent of Streets of said City is directed to post
18 said notices, both on behalf of said City Council.

19 Section 5: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption
20 of this ordinance and cause it to be published once in the
21 Riverside Daily Press. This ordinance shall become
22 effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.


