

RESOLUTION NO. 7833

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE OF INTENTION NO. 2513; AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING A PORTION OF THE OLD FOLLEY ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, adopted an ordinance of intention No. 2513 pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, declaring its intention to vacate a portion of the old Folley Road, therein and hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the matter came on regularly for hearing before said City Council at the time and place fixed for hearing by said ordinance of intention, and said City Council heard and considered all of the evidence submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said City Council that it be and it is hereby found and determined by said City Council that said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceedings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting, as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said portion of the old Folley Road therein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes and should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that that portion of old Folley Road, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows, to wit:

That portion of the Folley Road lying within the boundary of the City of Riverside as acquired by Annexation No. 3; as described by Ordinance No. 2257 passed by the City Council of the City of Riverside on September 13, 1935, and filed by the Secretary of State on October 14, 1935;

1 be, and the same is hereby, recorded.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of  
3 Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested  
4 by the Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the  
5 office of the County Recorder of Riverside County California.

ORDINANCE NO. 2513

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE A PORTION OF THE OLD PEDLEY ROAD; REFERRING TO MAP AS TO THE PORTION OF THE STREET SOUGHT TO BE VACATED; AND SETTING THE TIME OF HEARING.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, to vacate the hereinafter described portion of the old Pedley Road in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, upon the grounds and for the reason that said portion of said street is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes. The said City Council hereby elects and expresses its election to proceed to vacate said portion of said street pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.

Section 2: That the portion of said street which it is the intention of the City Council to vacate is described as follows:

That portion of the Pedley Road lying within the boundary of the City of Riverside as acquired by Annexation No. 3; as described by Ordinance No. 2257 passed by the City Council of the City of Riverside on September 13, 1955, and filed by the Secretary of State on October 14, 1955;

and that the portion of said street sought to be vacated is shown on that certain map on file with the City Clerk of Riverside, California, and reference is hereby made to said map on file.

Section 3: That the time of hearing is hereby set for Tuesday, the 23rd day of July, 1957, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California; at said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation may be heard.

Section 4: Notice of the proposed street vacation, as

1 hereinabove set forth, shall be posted conspicuously along the  
2 line of the portion of the street proposed to be vacated, and  
3 shall be posted not more than three hundred feet apart, but  
4 there shall be at least three such postings; said notice shall  
5 state the passage of the ordinance of intention, and the time  
6 and place of the hearing; said notice shall be posted by the  
7 Superintendent of Streets at least ten (10) days prior to the  
8 date of said hearing.

9 Section 5: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption  
10 of this ordinance and cause it to be published once in the  
11 Riverside Daily Press. This ordinance shall become  
12 effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
