Beginning at a point on the southerly line of Lot 35 of the Linwood Place Addition as shown on map recorded in Book 7 of Maps, Page 37, Records of Riverside County, California, said point lying 10 feet easterly from the most southwesterly corner of said Lot 35; thence northerly, parallel with and 10 feet from the westerly lines of Lots 35, 34, and 33 of the said Linwood Place Addition to a point on the northerly line of said Lot 33; thence westerly along the northerly line of said Lot 33 and the northerly line of Lot 27 of the said Linwood Place Addition, a distance of 15 feet; thence, southerly, parallel with and five-feet from the easterly line of said Lot 27 to a point on the southerly line of said Lot 27; thence easterly along the southerly line of said Lot 27 to a point on the westerly line of Lot 35 of the said Linwood Place Addition; thence southerly along the westerly line of said Lot 35 to the most southwesterly corner of said Lot 35; thence easterly along the southerly line of said Lot 35, to the point of beginning.
