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2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND  
4 DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF  
5 INTENTION NO. 9293 ; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND  
6 RIGHTS OF WAY AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC  
7 CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION  
8 OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY, AND MAKING  
9 ITS ORDER VACATING A PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY IN  
10 VICTORIA VILLAGE.

11 WHEREAS, on December 5, 1961 the City Council of the City  
12 of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9293 declaring its  
13 intention to order the vacation of a pedestrian walkway in  
14 Victoria Village, and fixing the time and place of hearing all  
15 persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the  
16 provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections  
17 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways  
18 Code of the State of California; and,

19 WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and  
20 acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside  
21 and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by  
22 said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

23 WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City  
24 Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons  
25 interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence  
26 submitted that the said pedestrian walkway hereinafter ordered  
27 vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City  
29 Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said  
30 pedestrian walkway in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside,  
31 State of California, described as follows:

32 That certain pedestrian walkway, 5 feet in width,  
shown as Lot "D" on Map of Victoria Village on file  
in Book 24, page 51 of Maps, Records of Riverside  
County, California;

Reserving therefrom easements and rights of way as  
set forth in Sections 8330 and 8331 of the Streets  
and Highways Code over, under and across the above  
described Lot "D",

be and the same is hereby vacated.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across the said pedestrian walkway to be vacated, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, water and incidental purposes including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth and otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the said pedestrian walkway to be vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
