Riverside, California RESOLUTION

1 On motion of Supervisor Hayden, seconded by Supervisor \_\_\_\_\_  
2 \_\_\_\_\_, and duly carried, the following resolution was adopted:

3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,  
4 State of California, in regular session assembled this 6th day of July,  
5 1954, that the following described strip of land is necessary to the public con-  
6 venience as a public highway, and is hereby declared open for use by the public  
7 as a county highway to be known as Jurupa Avenue; said real property is de-  
8 scribed as follows:

9 All of that portion of Lot 13, as shown on Map of the McClaskey Tract,  
10 filed in Book 13, pages 36 and 37 of Maps, and all that portion of Tract 2, as  
11 shown on Map of the River Farm Tract, filed in Book 7, page 52 of Maps, both  
12 of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, more particularly described  
13 as follows:

14 Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Jurupa Avenue and  
15 \_\_\_\_\_ of the McClaskey Tract;  
16 Thence N. 17° 12' 55" E., along the center line of said Tract 2,  
17 distance of 148.10 feet;

18 Thence S. 49° 40' 25" E., a distance of 190.70 feet to the center line of  
19 said Jurupa Avenue;

20 Thence S. 80° 02' 55" W., along said center line of Jurupa Avenue,  
21 of 101.37 feet to the point of beginning.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board be and he is  
23 authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be  
24 recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of the County of Riverside  
25 of California.
