RESOLUTION NO. 9905

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF ST. LAWRENCE STREET.

WHEREAS, on January 21, 1964, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9892 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a portion of St. Lawrence Street and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Section 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside, and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found, and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the portion of the street hereinafter ordered vacated is unnecessary for present and prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of the street located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

That portion of St. Lawrence Street (80 feet wide) as shown by map of Arlington Heights on file in Book 11, page 20 of Maps, Records of San Bernardino County, California, bounded northwesterly by the southeasterly line of the Canal of the Riverside Water Company and southeasterly by the northwesterly line of the right of way of the A. T. & S. F. Railway Company,

is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and the same be and is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of
