4 A PORTION OF FLORAL AVENUE.

5 WHEREAS, on April 14, 1964, the City Council of the
6 City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9954 declaring its
7 intention to order the vacation of a portion of Floral Avenue
8 and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested
9 in the proposed vacation pursuant to the provisions of the

15 and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by
16 said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

18 Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons
19 interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence
20 submitted that the portion of the street hereinafter ordered
21 vacated is unnecessary for present and prospective public use.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City
23 Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion
24 of the street located in the City of Riverside, County of
25 Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

26 Lots A and B of Belvedere Heights as shown by map
27 on file in Book 22, page 31 of Maps, Records of
28 Riverside County, California,

29 is unnecessary for present or prospective public use and the
30 same be and is hereby vacated.

31 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said
32 City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order,
attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be

1 recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside
2 County, California.
