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RESOLUTION ADOPTED GRANTING PETITION OF CHARLES A. MORROW ET AL TO VACATE ROAD IN 1ST DISTRICT.

4. That the public easement heretofore existing in said roads shall hereinafter cease and determine, and the title to the land previously subject shall revert to the respective owners free from such easements.

The roads hereinabove referred to, and herein vacated and abandoned, are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Morton Street as shown on Map of La Sierra Gardens as recorded in Map Book 11, pages 42 to 50 inclusive, in the office of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, lying between the northwesterly line of Magnolia Avenue and a line parallel with and distant 255 feet from the northwesterly line of said Magnolia Avenue.

4. That the public easement heretofore existing in said roads shall hereinafter cease and determine, and the title to the land previously subject shall revert to the respective owners free from such easements.

The roads hereinabove referred to, and herein vacated and abandoned, are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of the Cahuilla Road in Sections 20 & 21, T. 7 S., R 3 E., S.B.B. & M., as declared a public highway by the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County, California, in Road Book 3, page 266 thereof, the center line of which is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the center 1/4 section corner of said Section 21; thence West on the mid-section line, 1/2 mile to the 1/4 section corner on the west

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
