Said polls to be opened at 6 o'clock A. M. of said day, and remain open till 6 o'clock P. M. of said day when they shall be closed, and the Clerk of this board is directed to publish notice of said election in the Hemet News, a newspaper printed and published within said boundaries, for at least two weeks prior to said election, and shall also post the same for the same period in at least four public places therein.

Said notice shall conform to the law and shall require the voters to cast ballots, which shall contain the words "For Incorporation," or "Against Incorporation," and also the names of persons voted for to fill the various elective municipal offices provided by law for municipal corporations of the sixth class.

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The report of the viewers on the road petitioned for by F. D. Mears, et al., in the third road district and known as Linden Avenue Extension, was presented and duly considered by the Board.

Upon motion of Supervisor Carlton, seconded by Supervisor Kimbell and duly carried, it is ordered, that the report of the viewers be accepted and said road is hereby laid out and established as a Public Highway of Riverside County and described as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at a point on the west boundary of Section 19, T. 2 S. R. 4 W. S. B. B. M. from which the S. W. corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 1320 ft. being the center line of a street called Linden Street.

Thence East 1 mile along Linden St;

Thence East 1 mile between the N.  $\frac{1}{2}$  and the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 20, same township and range.

Thence East 1470 ft.;

Thence North 75° 45' E, distance 430 ft, to a point on the West side of the Southern California Railway.

The above described line being the center line of a strip of land 50 ft. in width.

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Claims numbered 5154 to 5262 inclusive were allowed by the Board, ordered entered in the allowance book; and the County Auditor is hereby directed to draw his warrants on the County Treasurer for the same.
