That portion of the City's right of way known as Chicago Avenue, underlying the overhanging eaves, canopies and similar structures extending from and attached to Permittee's residence fronting on Chicago Avenue and more particularly described as 3761 Chicago Avenue,

in accordance with the terms and provisions hereof.

Permittee shall use and occupy the described property exclusively for overhang of eaves, canopies and similar structures from Permittee's existing dwelling as above described.

All rights and privileges granted Permittee by this encroachment permit shall be irrevocable during the lifetime of Permittee and until the death of both Georgia E. Fountain and LaVerne Fountain; after the death of both Georgia E. Fountain and La Verne Fountain, all rights and privileges granted Permittee by this encroachment permit may be terminated by the City and this encroachment permit may be revoked upon notice of revocation by the City.
