

RESOLUTION NO. 524 (NEW SERIES)

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Resolved, that whereas the Common Council of the City of Riverside, State of California, did on the 21st day of June, 1921 pass its Resolution of Intention No. 521 (New Series) to order the hereinafter described work to be done, which resolution of intention was duly and legally published as required by law, as appears from the affidavit of J. R. Gabbert, now on file in the office of the Clerk of said City; and

Whereas, notices of said resolution, headed "Notice of Public Work", were duly and legally posted at several places and in the manner and form required by law, as appears from the affidavit of Chas. E. Games, who caused the same to be posted, now on file in the office of the Clerk of said City; and

Whereas, all protests or objections presented have been disposed of in time form and manner as required by law and the Common Council having now acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed work; and

Whereas, said proposed work is for closing up a portion of a public street, and it appears to said Common Council that no assessment is necessary,

It is hereby resolved by the Common Council of the City of Riverside, State of California, that the public interest and convenience require, and that the said Common Council hereby orders to be done, the work of closing up and vacating that street known as Herndon Avenue, and all of Riverside Drive as shown on the map of Hallet Park Tract as recorded in 12-3-42 Book 9 of Maps, page 53, Records of Riverside County, California, in accordance with said resolution of intention, declaring the intention of said Common Council to order said work to be done and it is hereby ordered that said work be done in accordance with said resolution of intention.

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
