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Resolution of the common Council of the City of Riverside declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of High Street in said City has been completed and that the same is closed up and vacated.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 14th. day of June, 1927, pass its Resolution No. 1144 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of High Street in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by resolution of intention No. 1115 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of High Street has been done and completed.

NOW WHEREFORE, be it resolved that the Common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that that certain portion of High Street in said City hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated. The portion of High Street referred to and effected by this resolution is described as follows; to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of lot 12, Carlton Place as recorded in book 8 of maps, page 79, records of Riverside County California, with Westerly line of High Street, said point being the P.I. of a curve with a radius of 37.6 feet; thence Southerly along the Westerly line of High Street to Southern termination as shown on map of Halls Add. to Riverside recorded in book 9 of Maps, page 3, records of San Bernardino, County, California, and Castleman's addition to Riverside as recorded in book 3, of maps, page 19, Records of San Bernardino County, California; thence Easterly 66 feet, thence Northerly along the Easterly line of High street at a point at right angles to the point of beginning; thence Westerly 66 feet;
