

## RESOLUTION NO. 1969 (NEW SERIES)

RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE CLOSING UP AND VACATING OF CERTAIN ALLEYS IN BLOCKS 5 AND 6, H. P. KEYES TRACT, HAS BEEN COMPLETED.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, California, did, on the 27th day of March, 1934, pas its resolution No. 1966 (New Series); ordering the work of closing up and vacating of certain alleys in Block 5 and 6, in the H.P. Keyes Tract in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by resolution of intention No. 1965 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has been done and completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the said Council hereby determines that the said alleys, hereinafter described, are closed up and vacated, to-wit:

The Westerly 215 feet of the Alley in Block 6, of the H. P. Keyes Tract, lying immediately Southerly of and parallel with Seventh Street, between Eucalyptus Avenue and Franklin Avenue; also all that certain alley in Block 5, of the H. P. Keyes Tract, lying immediately Northerly of and parallel with Seventh Street, between Eucalyptus Avenue and Franklin Avenue.

Albert Mills, the duly elected, qualified and acting City Clerk of the City of Riverside, California, hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly and regularly introduced and adopted by the Council of said City, at its meeting held on the 10th day of April, 1934, by the following vote;
