RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A DEED.

RESOLVED, that that certain deed of the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation, granting to Agnes Hole Rindge and undivided three-quarters interest, and Samuel K.
