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THIS INDENTURE, made the 19th day of October, A. D., 1926, between CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation of the State of California, the party of the first part, and (MRS) AGNES MILLS, of Riverside, Riverside, County, California; the party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to it in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has remised, released, and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents does remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns all the certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of Lot 24, Rosewood Addition, as recorded in Book 8 of Maps, page 33, Records of Riverside County, California; thence Westerly along the northerly line of said Lot 24 produced westerly to a point 37 feet easterly from the westerly line of Lot 230 of the Southern California Colony Association Lands as recorded in Book 7 of Maps, page 3, Records of San Bernardino County, California; thence Southerly parallel with the Westerly line of said Lot 230 to the point of intersection with the southerly line of said Lot 24, produced westerly; thence easterly along the southerly line of said Lot 24 produced westerly to the southwest corner of said Lot 24; thence northerly along the Westerly line of said lot 24 to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER WITH all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest,

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property, possession, claim and demand, whatsoever, as well in law as in equity of the said party of the first part, of in or to the said premises and every part and parcel thereof, with appurtenances.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns forever.
