The City of Riverside, a municipal corporation, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) to it in hand paid, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto HELEN LOHRLI, an unmarried woman, all that certain real property situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, more, particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The Northerly $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet of a portion of the abandoned right of way of the lower Canal of the Riverside Water Company in the Northeast corner of the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 33, and the fractional Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, S. B. B. & M., as recorded in Book 2 of Maps, Records of San Bernardino County, California, extended in a Northwesterly direction from the Westerly property line of Palm Avenue, the Westerly extremity being 250 feet at right angles from the Westerly line of Palm Avenue.
