A strip of land of the uniform width of forty (40) feet, lying Easterly of and adjacent to Lot 4, Block 44, Arlington Heights as shown by Map recorded in Book 11 of Maps, page 20 and 21, Records of San Bernardino County, California, said strip of land being a portion of the Westerly half of ~~the~~ St. Lawrence Street, now abandoned; Also a strip of land of the uniform width of forty (40) feet, lying Westerly of and adjacent to Lot 3, Block 47, Arlington Heights, as shown by Map recorded in Book 11 of Maps, pages 20 and 21, Records of San Bernardino County, California, said strip of land being a portion of the Easterly half of St. Lawrence Street, now abandoned;
