

RESOLUTION NO. 5961

1 RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE
 2 CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING PORTIONS OF THE
 3 PEDESTRIAN WALKS IN JONES TRACT NO. 3.

4 WHEREAS, on the 28th day of July, 1953, Ordinance No. 1938
 5 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the
 6 intention of the City Council to vacate portions of the pedestrian
 7 walks in Jones Tract No. 3, pursuant to the provisions of the Public
 8 Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

9 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tues-
 10 day, September 15, 1953, at 10 o'clock A.M. in the Council Chambers
 11 located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside,
 12 California, at which said time and place all persons interested in
 13 or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

14 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section
 15 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

16 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before
 17 said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time
 18 the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legis-
 19 lative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence
 20 submitted that the portions of the pedestrian walks which the legis-
 21 lative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for
 22 present or prospective public use.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City
 24 of Riverside, California, that the portions of the pedestrian walks
 25 in Jones Tract No. 3, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside,
 26 State of California, and described as follows:

27 All of Lots D, E and F as shown on a map of Jones Tract No. 3
 28 recorded in Map Book 25, page 73, Records of Riverside County;
 29 EXCEPT the following described portions to be reserved for public
 30 utility easements:

31 That portion of Lot D, beginning at a point in the northerly line
 32 eighteen (18) feet easterly from the westerly line of said lot;
 33 thence easterly along said northerly line a distance of twelve
 34 (12) feet; thence southerly across said Lot D to a point in the
 35 southerly line, a distance of twenty-six and sixty hundredths
 36 (26.60) feet from the westerly line of said Lot D; thence westerly
 37 along said southerly line a distance of twelve (12) feet; thence
 38 northerly across said Lot D to the point of beginning;

39 That portion of Lot E lying five (5) feet on each side of the
 40 southerly extension of the line between Lots 65 and 82 of said
 41 Jones Tract No. 3;

42 That portion of Lot F lying between a line which is parallel with
 43 and five (5) feet easterly from the southerly extension of the
 44 line between Lots 43 and 60; and a line which is parallel with and
 45 and eighteen (18) feet westerly from the said southerly extension
 46 of the line between Lots 43 and 60;

47 THIS ORDER, attested by my hand under seal, to be recorded in the Office
 48 of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
