

E A S E M E N T

THIS INDENTURE, made this 2nd day of April, 1954, by and between Joseph Hunter Foundation, a non-profit California Corporation, party of the first part, and the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a Municipal Corporation, in the County of Riverside, State of California, party of the second part; WITNESSETH:

THAT in consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States to the party of the first part in hand paid by the party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part does by these presents grant unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, a right of way and easement for the construction, maintenance, operation, inspection, repair, replacement and removal of water works instrumentation facilities, including such additional facilities as said Grantee may from time to time in future require, upon, over, and across that certain real property situate in the County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

A portion of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, in the County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 18, being the intersection of the centerlines of Columbia Avenue and Iowa Avenue; thence North $89^{\circ} 44'$ West along the South line of said Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter a distance of fifty (50) feet; thence North $00^{\circ} 08'$ West along the West line of Iowa Avenue a distance of one hundred ninety-five (195) feet to the point of beginning. Thence continuing North $00^{\circ} 08'$ West a distance of ten (10) feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 44'$ West and parallel to the South line of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 18, a distance of fifteen (15) feet; thence South $00^{\circ} 08'$ East and parallel with the West line of Iowa Avenue, a distance of ten (10) feet; thence South $89^{\circ} 44'$ West and parallel to the South line of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section, a distance of fifteen (15) feet to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER WITH the right of entry upon said premises over and across which said easement and right-of-way is granted, for the purpose of installing, maintaining and repairing said facilities, and to enjoy the use of said easement and right-of-way free and clear of buildings, trees and other obstructions.


