

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ACCEPTING DEEDS

RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Riverside, that those certain deeds to the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation, of the County of Riverside, State of California, and covering the premises therein set forth and briefly described as follows, to-wit:

1. Deed dated July 1, 1921, executed by the Riverside Title Company, a corporation, for a strip of land sixty (60) feet in width beginning at St. Lawrence Street and the Elsinore Road and running in a northwesterly direction to Central Avenue, being more particularly shown on a map attached to deed recorded in Book 433, page 250 of Deeds, Records of Riverside County, California;

2. Deed dated May 27, 1921, executed by Fannie A. Harter, for a sewer right-of-way between Lots 12 and 13, Elliott Subdivision, as recorded in Book 8 of Maps, page 66, Records of Riverside County, California,
