"A strip of land running from north to south across the Government Tract under the Upper Riverside Irrigating Canal, embracing 25 feet on each side of a line commencing at the north east corner of the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section 34, in T. 2 S., R. 5 West of the San Bernardino Base Line and Meridian, thence south one mile to its intersection with the north line of Township No. 3."

"And it is expressly understood that the above described property is granted to the County aforesaid, to be held and used forever as a Public Highway,
