A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 17257; RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR ELECTRICAL ENERGY DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES AND FOR AERIAL AND UNDERGROUND TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND COMMUNICATION FACILITIES, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING AN ALLEY BETWEEN LAFAYETTE AND JACKSON STREETS, SOUTHERLY OF GARFIELD STREET.

WHEREAS on September 12, 1989, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 17257 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a 20-foot-wide by approximately 850-foot-long alley situated between Lafayette and Jackson Streets and southerly of Garfield Street, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the alley ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

1           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of  
2 the City of Riverside, California, that the alley in the City of  
3 Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described  
4 in the document attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and by this  
5 reference made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby  
6 vacated.

7           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby  
8 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the  
9 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way for  
10 electric energy facilities, and reserving the right to  
11 construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge  
12 lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other  
13 convenient structures, equipment and fixtures, as may be  
14 applicable, for the transportation or distribution of electric  
15 energy; and a permanent easement and right of way to construct,  
16 place, operate, inspect, maintain, repair, replace and remove  
17 communication structures as the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph  
18 Company may from time to time require consisting of poles,  
19 anchors, wires, cables, conduits, manholes, markers and  
20 necessary fixtures and appurtenances; including access and the  
21 right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and  
22 wood growth that would interfere with the use of said permanent  
23 easements and rights of way.

24           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacation shall occur  
25 only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning  
26 Department's report to the legislative body, and on file with  
27 the City Clerk, have been satisfied; and the City Clerk is

1 hereby directed not to record this resolution of vacation until  
2 the applicable conditions have been satisfied.

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

VAC-2-890 - Vacation of a 20-foot-wide by approximately 850-foot-long alley lying southeasterly of Garfield Street between Lafayette Street and Jackson Street.

That portion of Lots 33 and 34 in Block XII of the Village of Arlington, as shown by map on file in Book 1, Page 62 of Maps, records of San Bernardino County, California conveyed to the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation, as Parcel B of Grant Deed recorded September 24, 1963, as Instrument No. 100740 of Official Records of Riverside County, California, described as follows:

A 20-foot-wide strip of land being the portions of said Lots 33 and 34 of the Village of Arlington lying northeasterly of and contiguous with the northeasterly lines of Lots 14 through 25, inclusive, of Kruse Tract, as shown by map on file in Book 28, Page 29 of Maps, records of said Riverside County. The northeasterly line of said 20-foot-wide strip shall be lengthened or shortened as required to terminate northwesterly in the southeasterly line of Garfield Street (80-foot-wide) and southeasterly in the northwesterly line of Lafayette Street (66-foot-wide);

RESERVING THEREFROM a permanent easement and right-of-way for electrical energy distribution facilities;

ALSO RESERVING THEREFROM a permanent easement and right-of-way for aerial and underground telephone, telegraph and communication facilities.
