TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION
EASEMENT

FOR VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, **RIVERSIDE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**, a Public Agency of the State of California, who acquired title as **RIVERSIDE JUNIOR COLLEGE SCHOOL DISTRICT**, as Grantor, grants to the **CITY OF RIVERSIDE**, a municipal corporation of the State of California, as Grantee, its successors and assigns, a temporary easement and right-of-way for the construction and installation of **storm drain facilities**, together with all necessary appurtenances, in, under, upon, over and along that certain real property located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

Parcel 1

THAT portion of Lots 154 and 166 of the lands of the **SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA COLONY ASSOCIATION**, as shown by map recorded in Book 7 of Maps, at page 3 thereof, records of San Bernardino County, California, described as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the centerline of **TERRACINA DRIVE**

(formerly North Street) with the centerline of **MAGNOLIA AVENUE** as shown by map of THE POLY TRACT, on file in Book 8 of Maps, at page 56 thereof, records of Riverside County, California;

THENCE North $42^{\circ}40'00''$ East, along said centerline of Magnolia Avenue, 350.50 feet;



Said temporary construction easement is to be used for all purposes proper and convenient in the construction and installation of **storm drain facilities**, including the rights of ingress and egress, the temporary deposit of tools, equipment, machinery, vehicles, materials and supplies used in the performance of said work, and for similar and related purposes by the City of Riverside, its officers, employees, agents or contractors.

Upon completion of construction, the City of Riverside shall remove all debris, waste or excess material, brush or other matter or material deposited or placed upon the land, and with the exception of vegetation, return the surface as near as possible to its condition


before construction.

This construction easement shall terminate upon completion of the work of constructing the **storm drain** or within one year of the date of recording this document, whichever occurs first.






